

The International Master in Finance is a 14-month, full-time, 35 credit-hour programme that prepares students with essential analytical, problem-solving competencies in the financial area, contact with financial institutions and work on real-world cases, to understand and apply advanced financial tools employed in world financial markets. All courses are offered in English.

Professionals who are knowledgeable in these tools are highly sought after by financial institutions, business firms, multilateral organisations and public agencies.

This programme is jointly offered by **Nova School of Business & Economics, and Universidad de los Andes School of Management**. Both schools hold the renowned "triple crown" accreditation from AACSB, AMBA and EQUIS. **Which is the highest possible recognition that a business school can achieve worldwide**.

All programme faculty are financial specialists, holding a Ph.D. Many are top-level consultants to leading financial institutions, major corporations and multilateral agencies.

In 2018, Nova University's International Master in Finance was ranked 21th by the Financial Times listing of Masters in Finance programmes.

DEGREE AWARDED

Students completing the programme are awarded two degrees, one by NOVA (Master in Finance) and one by Universidad de los Andes (Magister Internacional en Finanzas).

GRADUATE PROFILE

Graduates of the International Master in Finance boast a solid knowledge of finance, analytical skills, and a broad international and intercultural perspective. They are equipped to interpret the financial dynamics that bear on organizations in a globalized economy. Graduates of the IMF will likely pursue an international career in asset management, equity research, M&A and private equity, or in strategic consulting, derivatives, and other financial areas.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the programme are expected to hold an undergraduate degree in Economics, Business, Finance, Engineering, or other fields requiring strong quantitative skills.

No previous experience in finance is necessary.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Applicants to the programme are invited to complete the available form on our web page, https://administracion.uniandes.edu.co attaching the requested documentation (GMAT or PAEP test scores), and participating in a personal interview.

Location

The International Master in Finance programme is offered in Bogota, Colombia and Lisbon, Portugal, with a one-week study trip to different countries in the world. Studies begin in Bogota (Cycle 1), continue in Lisbon (Cycle 2), and feature supervised research to be undertaken in Bogota or Lisbon (Cycle 3).

The International Master in Finance offers a multicultural experience, with students and faculty members representing over 25 nationalities. Studies during one semester are offered in Bogota, and in a second semester offered in Lisbon with a one-week study trip to different countries in the world. The final two months focus on the preparation of a final project; students can fulfill therequirement either Bogota or Lisbon.
