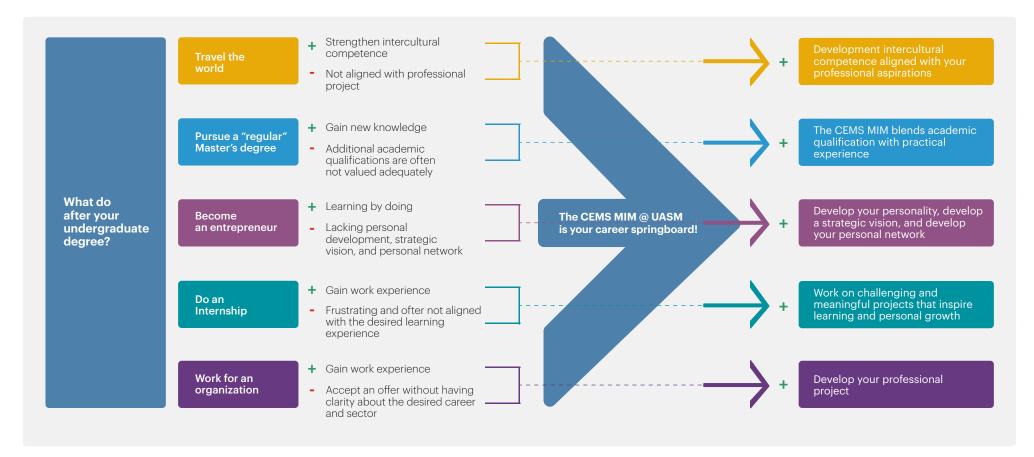

Our graduates champion a holistic vision of responsible business decision-making, leadership and citizenship, informed by ethical reasoning, personal integrity, and respect for social diversity.

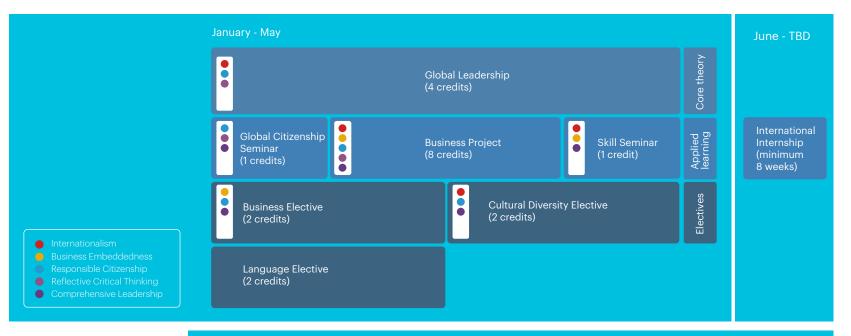

ADMISSION PROCESS

Applications to the CEMS MIM comply with Uniandes' general requirements for attending postgraduate studies.

The following items are required (in English except otherwise noted):

Letter of motivation

Admissions form

Accredited degrees and official transcripts (in certified Spanish or English translation)

Passport photograph

Letter of recommendation (to be submitted directly to the admissions committee)

Up-to date CV

GMAT or GRE test scores*
(requirement does not apply to current students and graduates of Universidad de los Andes)

Application video (link)

Proof of proficiency in English. Considered can be any of the following:

- TOEFL IBT (minimum 100)*
- IELTS (minimum 7.0)*
- A Bachelor's diploma entirely taught in English from a CEMS or EQUIS/AACSB accredited school
- An undergraduate degree issued in an English-speaking country
- Declaration of being a native English speaker

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to a personal interview (in Bogotá or by video conference). The Academic Director and one additional member of UASM's CEMS team interview every shortlisted candidate.

Timing: The semester starts in the beginning of August and applications have to be received by the end of February (wave 1) or by the end of April (wave 2). The exact dates will be published on UASM's website.

*Careful: Test scores expire and need to be valid at the time of application.
